## Single unbuffered inverter

## 1. General description

The 74HC1GU04 is a single unbuffered inverter. Inputs include clamp diodes. This enables the use of current limiting resistors to interface inputs to voltages in excess of  $V_{CC}$ .

## 2. Features and benefits

- Wide supply voltage range from 2.0 to 6.0 V
- High noise immunity
- Symmetrical output impedance
- CMOS low power dissipation
- Balanced propagation delays
- Latch-up performance exceeds 100 mA per JESD 78 Class II Level B
- Complies with JEDEC standards
  - JESD8C (2.7 V to 3.6 V)
  - JESD7A (2.0 V to 6.0 V)
- ESD protection:
  - HBM EIA/JESD22-A114-A exceeds 2000V
  - MM EIA/JESD22-A115-A exceeds 200V
- Specified from -40 °C to 85 °C and -40 °C to 125 °C



V<sub>CC</sub> = supply voltage in Volts.

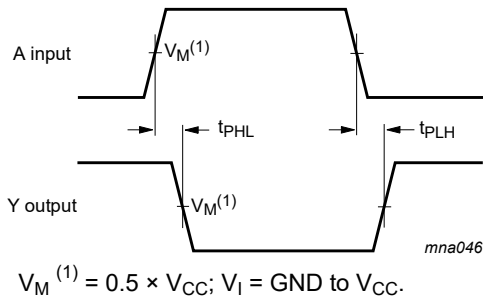
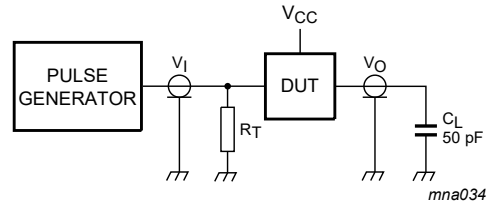


Fig. 5. Input to output propagation delays

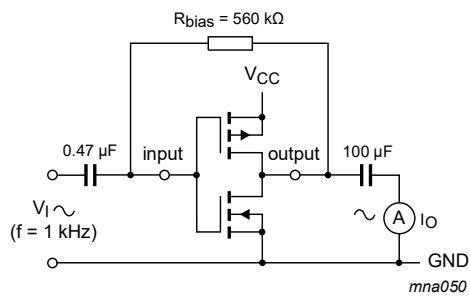
DUT = Device Under Test

$R_T$  = Termination resistance should be equal to output impedance  $Z_o$  of the pulse generator.

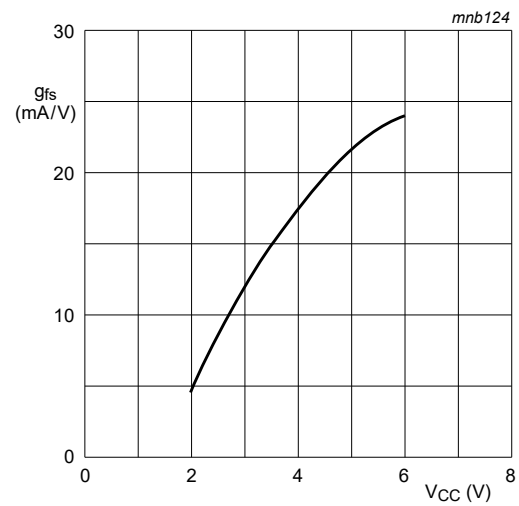
Fig. 6. Test circuit for measuring switching times

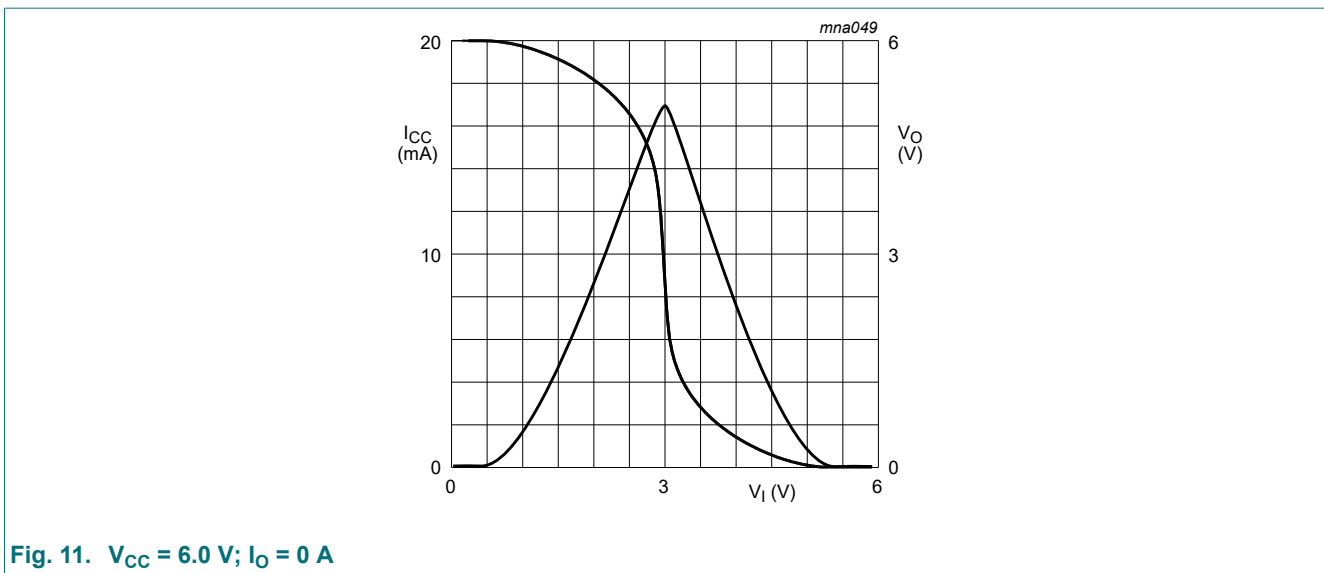
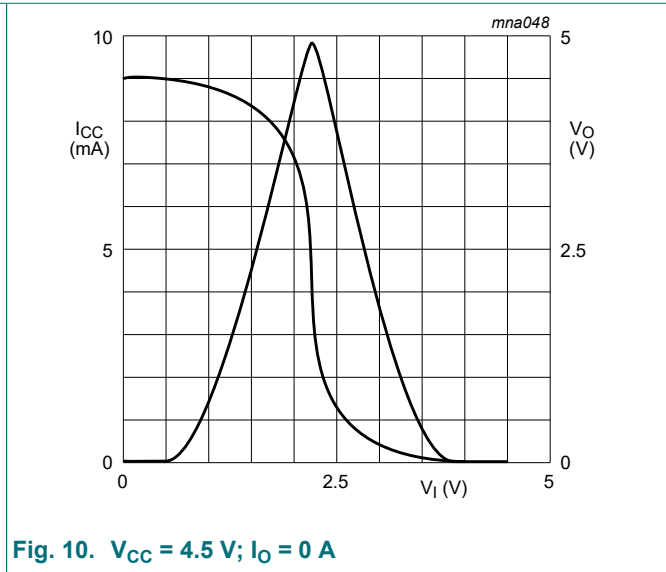
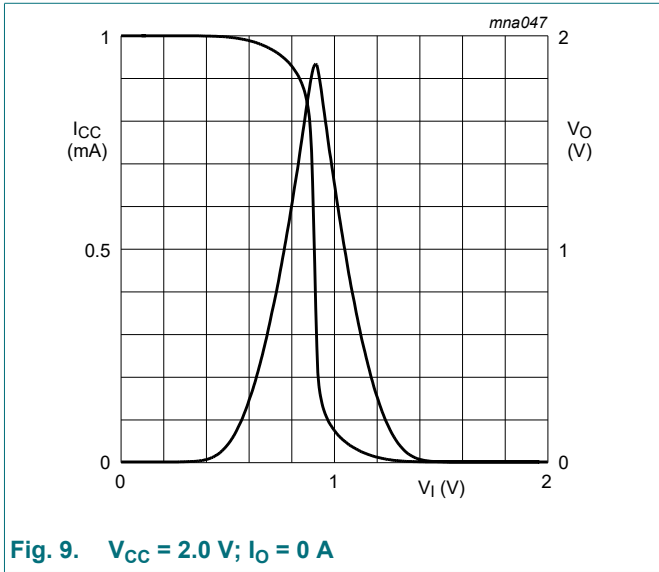
Fig. 7. Test set-up for measuring forward transconductance

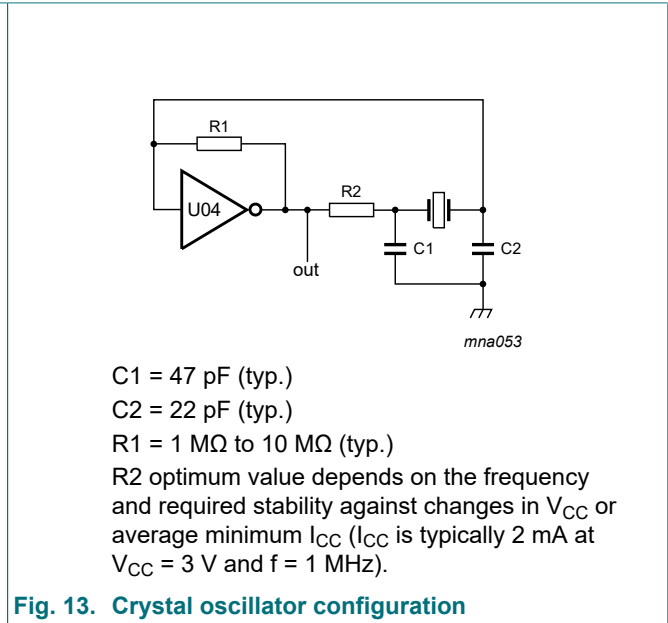
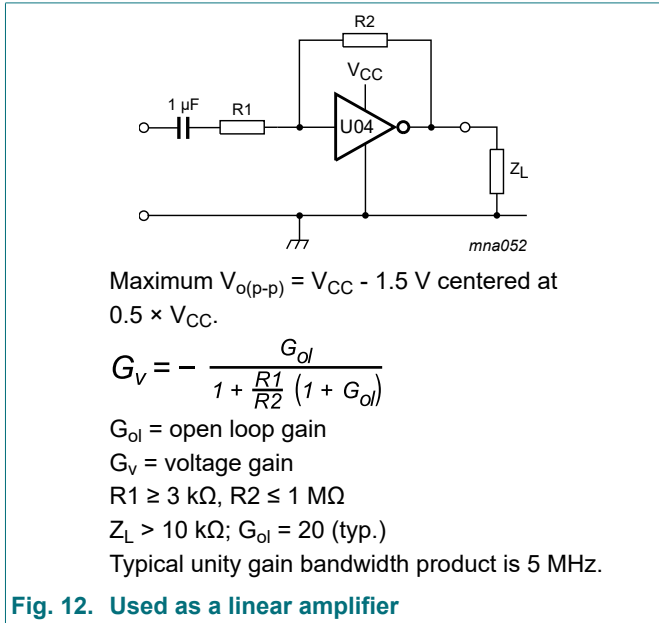

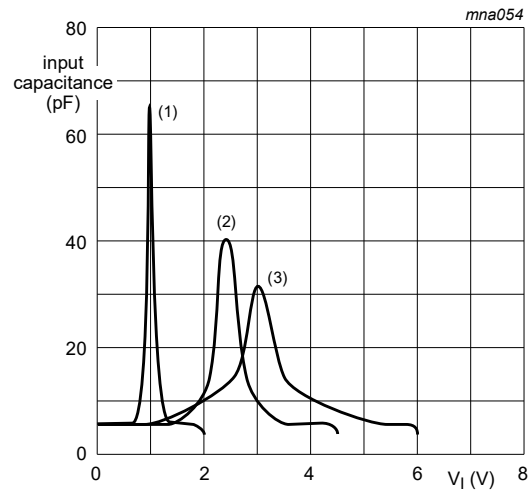

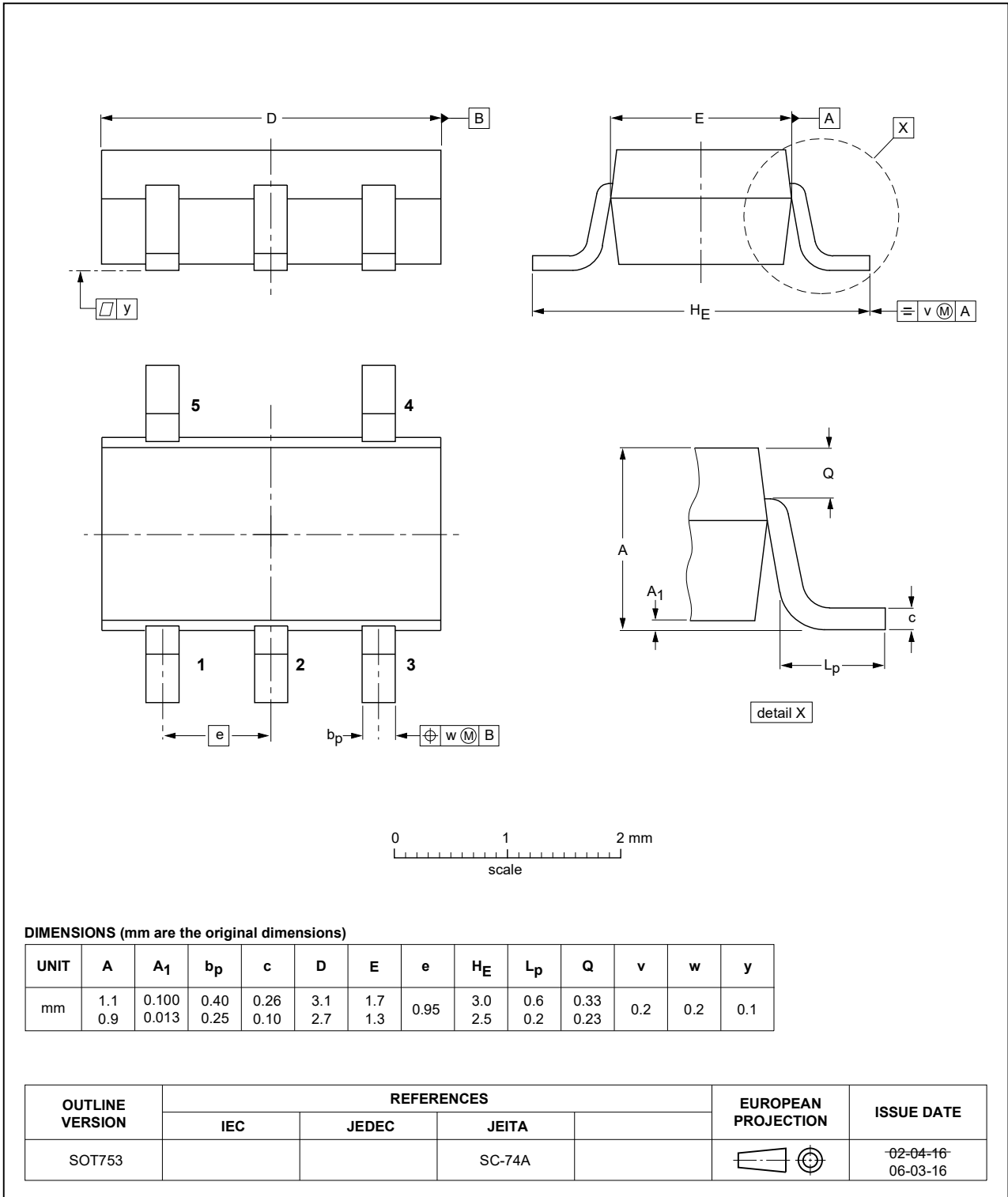


Fig. 16. Package outline SOT753 (SC-74A)
